In the scientific field, I have conducted research on chaos theory at UCSD, as well as intelligence and artificial life. My focus has been on applications in sustainable development, smart cities, and smart communities.

In the realm of art, I co-founded the Plancton Art Studio group in 1994. Our goal was to produce digital images and interactive installations blending art and science. I have been actively engaged in the international digital art scene and developed the Art of Emergence approach.

My works have been showcased in several international exhibitions in Los Angeles, New Orleans, Washington, Munich, London, Lima, Moscow, Girona, Rome, Turin, and Venice. I have received various awards, including the cover feature of the International Journal of Art-Science, Leonardo (MIT Press) in 2002. One of my contributions was selected by NASA as part of a collection by 60 artist-scientists for the library of the first human settlement on Mars in 2030.
